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## **Directions for filling out Declaration of Freedom to Marry (Form B)**

There should be a two witness for the bride and two witnesses for the groom. Parental testimony is preferred. The next option would be from a close family member. An additional option would be from a close friend who has known the person since the age of 18.

## **Future in-laws are discouraged from being the witnesses regarding freedom to Marry.** Bride and Groom can not witness for one another regarding freedom to Marry.

Form B must be dated, signed, and sealed by either a public notary, Priest, Deacon or Pastoral Minister.
